

# **ENROLMENT AND PARENT PAYMENTS**

#### **Enrolments**

Information on how to find, enrol, and start a child in your care at a school in Victoria is available on the <u>Victorian</u> government website.

## To enrol your child at our school:

# **Required documents**

### Required documentation includes:

- Completed enrolment form
- Evidence of identity and date of birth (for example, a <u>birth certificate</u> or passport)
- Immunisation Status Certificate

You will also be required to provide information about:

- your contact details
- emergency contact details
- health information about your child (such as allergies or illnesses they need to manage)
- other legal orders relating to your child and their welfare (if any)

#### School zones

Our school zone is available on <u>findmyschool.vic.gov.au</u> which hosts the most up-to-date information about Victorian school zones.

Students residing in our school zone are guaranteed a place at our school, which is determined on the basis of your permanent residential address.

The Department provides guidance through the <u>Enrolment: Placement Policy</u> to ensure that students have access to their designated neighbourhood school and the freedom to choose other schools, subject to facility limitations.
